INSTRUCTION MANUAL

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1. GENERAL INFORMATION

This user`s manual describes Volk Pictor Prestige Studio module (hereinafter – Volk Pictor Prestige Studio) functionalities and operation with Volk Pictor Prestige Studio.

Seeking to ensure patient safety, software should be used by intended use. You should therefore ensure that you are thoroughly familiar with the user manual before setting up and using Volk Pictor Prestige Studio for the first time.

Volk Pictor Prestige Studio does not replace medical professionals and could be used only as an additional tool.

Please note that medical images quality, sharpness, accuracy and other parameters, relevant to the users, directly depends on the technical capabilities of medical device, which is generating medical images, on the monitor and printer technical capabilities.

Indications for Use: Volk Pictor Prestige Studio is a software medical imaging system used to receive DICOM images, scheduling information and textual reports, organize and store them in an internal format, and to make that information available across a network via web and customized user interfaces. Software is intended for use as a diagnostic, review and analysis tool by trained professionals such as radiologists, physicians, clinicians.

Note: The Volk Pictor Prestige Studio is not intended for intensive care monitoring of vital physiological parameters, where the nature of variations is such that it could result in immediate danger to the patient.

Contraindications: The Volk Pictor Prestige Studio is not intended for the acquisition of mammographic image data and is meant to be used by qualified medical personnel only who are qualified to create and diagnose medical image data.

2. INTRODUCTION

Volk Pictor Prestige Studio software (hereinafter referred to as Volk Pictor Prestige Studio) is a unique medical device designed to aid professionals in sending medical images to PACS (or DICOM Archive). Sending is performed automatically as the user saves the study. Pictor Prestige ensures storage and provision of worldwide-standards compliant digital medical data: images generated by Pictor Prestige ophthalmic camera (hereinafter referred to as Camera). Images are downloaded via a USB interface (once the Camera is connected to a docking station or directly with a USB cable). The images are automatically imported into Pictor Prestige Studio and assembled into medical studies with associated patient data.

3. WORKPLACE DESKTOP SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

3.1 MINIMAL REQUIREMENTS

Volk Pictor Prestige Studio software is intended to be installed on the PCs, servers or other hardware systems. Customers are responsible for installing this software in a secured network and follow their institutional best practices and guidance. Volk is not responsible for misuse of this software. Hardware requirements as well as OS and other supporting software requirements for Volk Pictor Prestige Studio Pictor Prestige Studio are listed below:

- 1.5 GHz or faster x86-compatible processor;
- 2 GB RAM;
- 10 GB free hard drive space;
- Screen resolution 1024x768;
- Microsoft(R) Windows(R) Windows 7 (32 bit and 64 bit), Windows 10 (32 bit and 64 bit);
- Software install space ~200MB;

4. SOFTWARE INSTALLATION

If third party programs are interfering with Volk Pictor Prestige Studio installation process - computer user must stop or remove third party programs.

Virus and other spyware programs must be removed before Volk Pictor Prestige Studio installation or further usage on the same computer.



Before installation process make sure that the time and date are set correctly in order to provide smooth software operation.

To install Volk Pictor Prestige Studio software, download PictorPrestigeStudioSetup-x.xx.exe file.

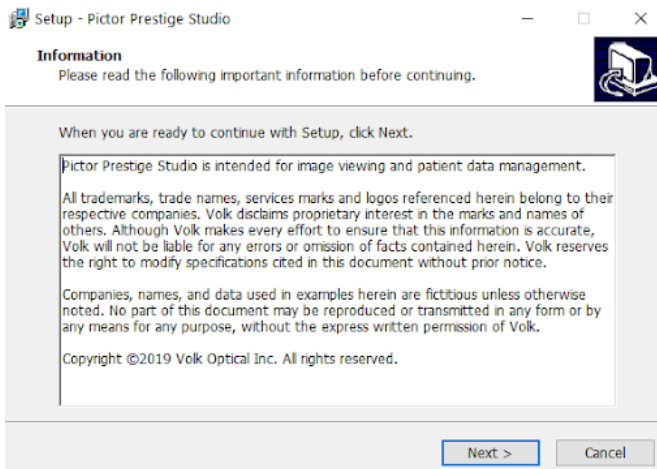


Figure 1. Volk Pictor Prestige Studio installation.

Once the file is downloaded, open it. The following Installation window will appear (see Fig. 1). Read the disclaimer and copyrights information, then press “Next” button.

Read “For your Consideration” about anonymous statistics and press “Next” button.

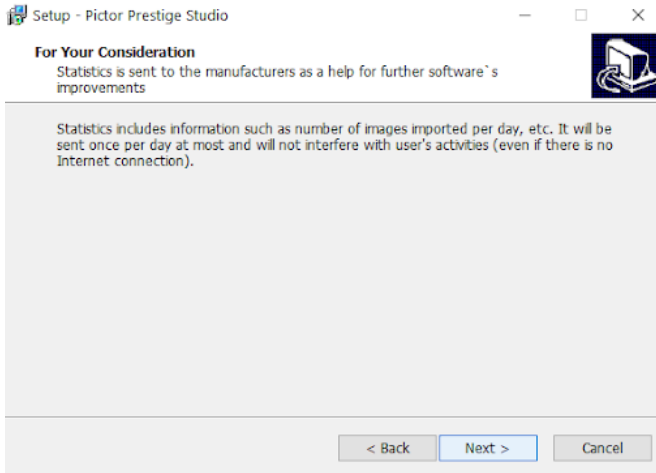


Figure 2. Volk Pictor Prestige Studio notification about anonymous statistics.

Choose the place where Volk Pictor Prestige Studio will be installed on your computer. Once you have selected the location, press “Next” button.



The minimum free disk space is 491 MB, make sure that the location where you install the software has this amount of free space.

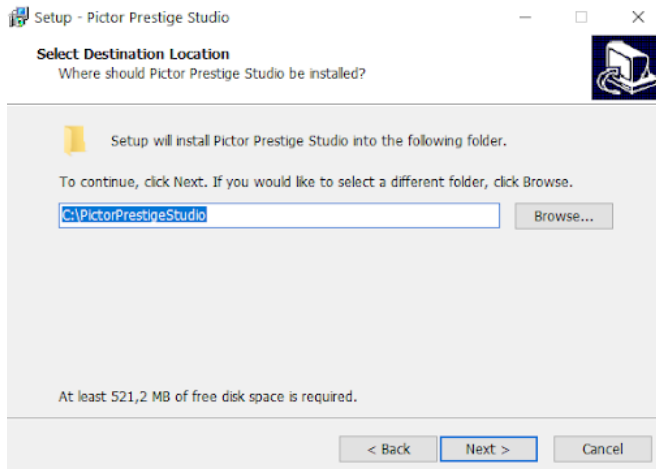


Figure 3. Selecting the installation location.

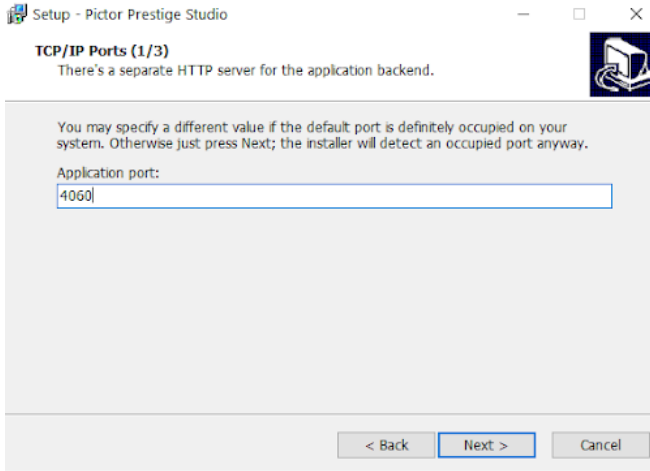


Figure 4. “TCP/IP Ports” installation dialog.

Leave the default values in “TCP/IP Ports” installation dialog (see Fig. 4). However, secure that 80 port is free. If you are already using 80 port (usually it may be used by Apache or IIS WEB servers), select any other port for WEB connection (recommended 8080, 8000 ports). Press “Next” in all 3 “TCP/IP Ports” installation dialogs.

Press “Next” button in “DICOM Listener Configuration” installation dialog.

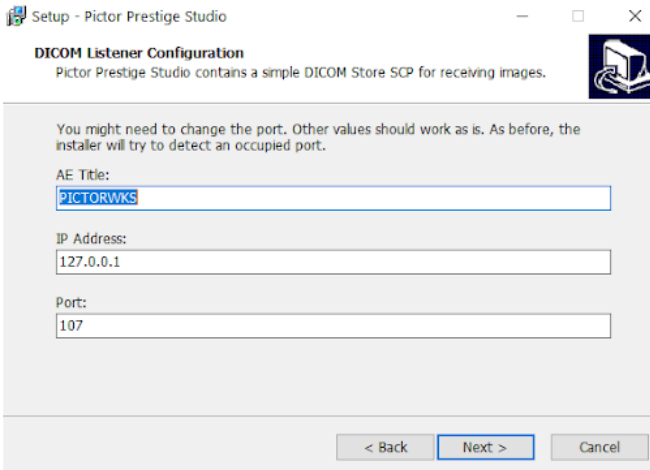


Figure 5. DICOM Listener Configuration.

Select the Start Menu Folder or leave as it is and press “Next” button.

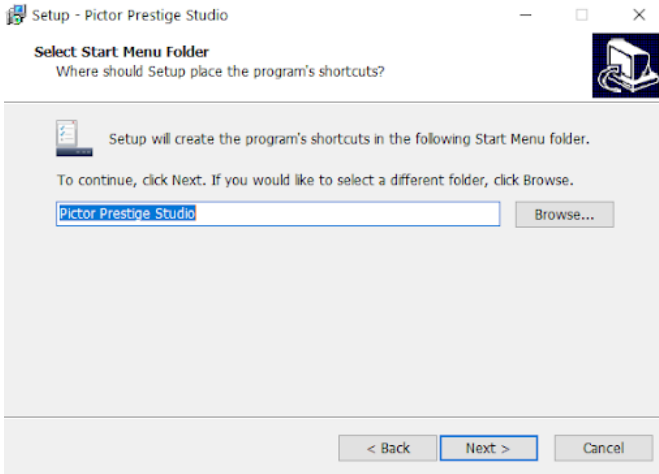


Figure 6. Start Menu folder selection.

Select the language of Pictor Prestige Studio user interface and press “Next”.

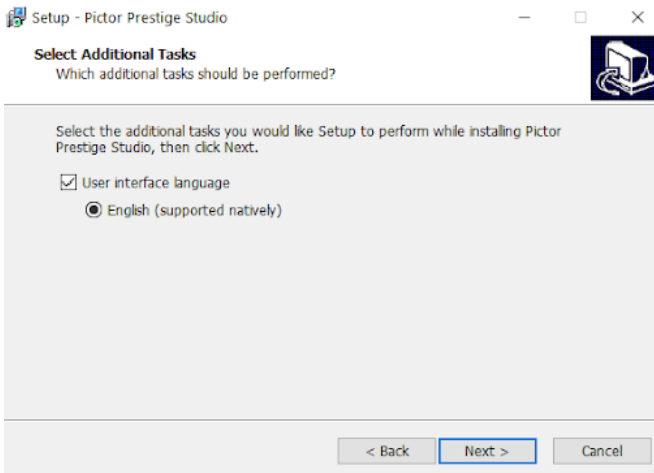


Figure 7. Language selection.

After the last step, a “Ready to install” window will appear, where you can overview all your selected options. To proceed, press “Install” button.

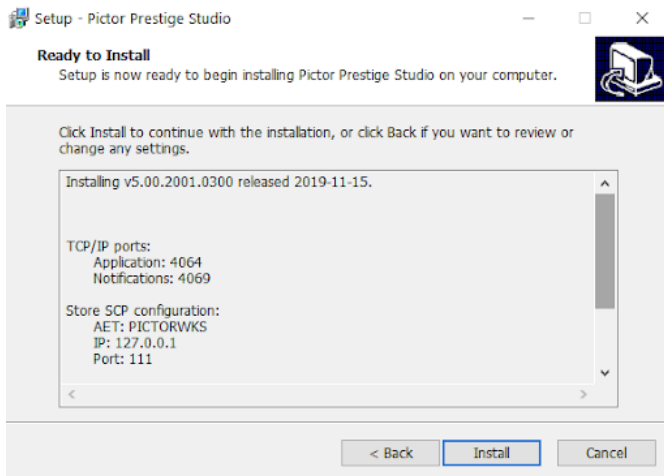


Figure 8. Ready to install window.

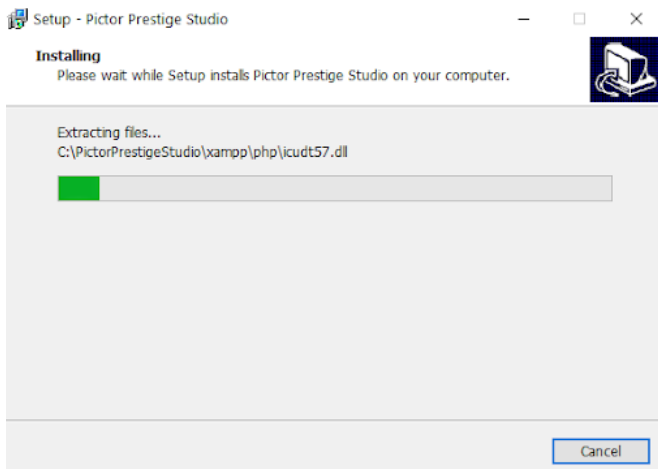


Figure 9. Software installation.

Please wait several minutes till the software finishes installing process and then press “Finish” button.

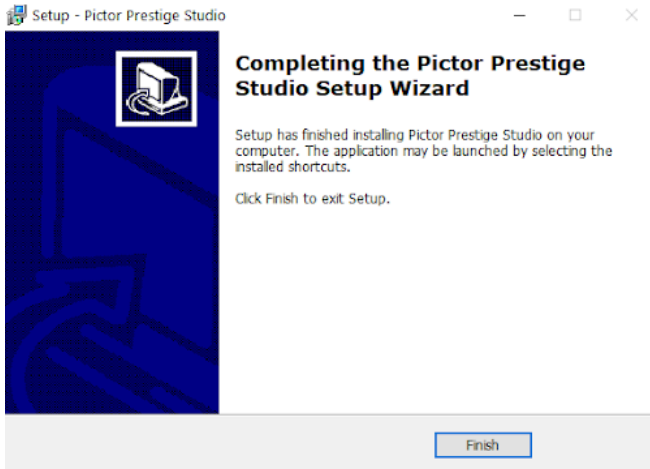


Figure 10. Installation complete.



It is recommended to reboot your computer once the installation process is complete.

5. LICENSE REGISTRATION

To activate Volk Pictor Prestige Studio for legal use, open Volk Pictor Prestige Studio. As a notification about the DEMO version appears, click the “Register” button.

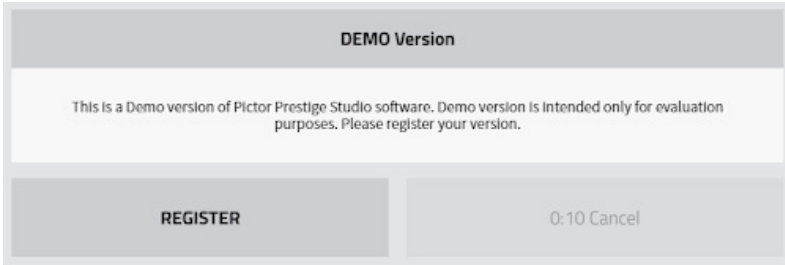


Figure 11. Notification about the demo version.

The registration window will appear. Fill the form and press the “Register for free trial” button or “Activate full version”. Full version can only be activated once you have got the “Activation code”.

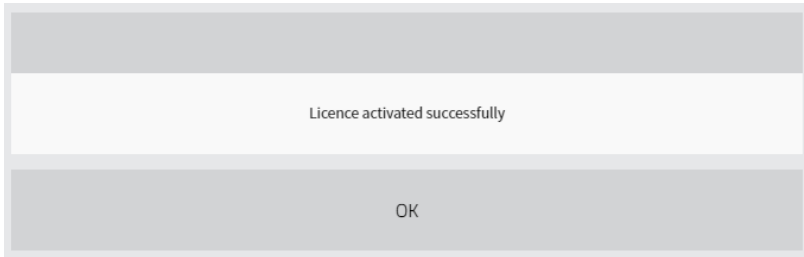


Figure 13. Pop-up message about license activation.

Once the registration is successful for full version, the following window will appear (Fig 13.). Click “OK” to close the window and you will be able to use your full version.

In case of free trial license activation, the following window will appear. Click “OK” to close the window and you will be able to use your trial version.

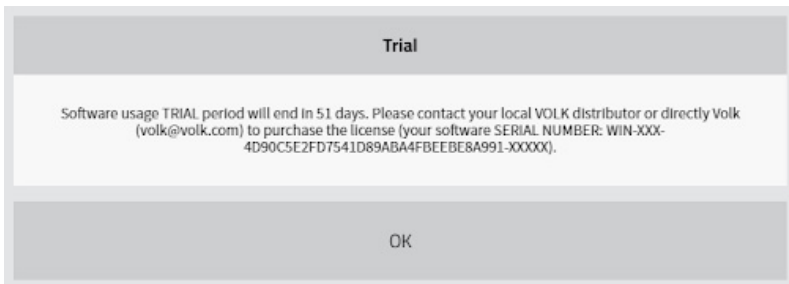


Figure 14. Pop-up message about trial license activation.

6. OPEN VOLK PICTOR PRESTIGE STUDIO

Volk Pictor Prestige Studio software is a desktop application which can be started from:

- standard Windows start menu (*Start>All Programs>Volk Pictor Prestige Studio>Pictor Prestige Studio*)
- installation directory (default:*C:\PictorPrestigeStudio*) by running *PictorPrestigeStudio.exe*.

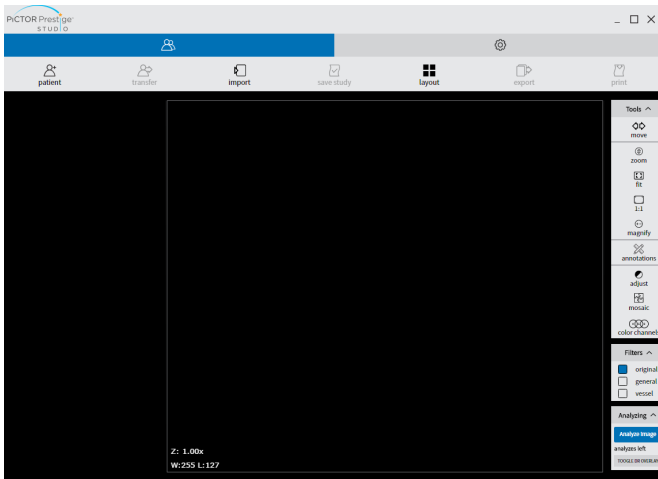




Figure 15. Desktop application window.

Wait a few seconds till the application starts and the window as in Figure 15 will open.

 If the license has a set “Valid to” date, every time when the software is launched the notification displayed in Fig. 14 will be shown. In the notification, the user can see the number of days till the trial period ends and where to contact to purchase the license.

The “OK” button is used to exit the notification.

 Desktop application does not require to login. It has full access to manage users and possibility to import studies from camera.

7. STUDY IMPORT

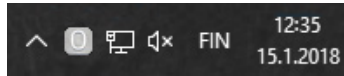


Figure 16. Pictor Prestige Studio Event Monitor.

Once Volk Pictor Prestige Studio is installed, you will see a small notification icon of a camera in the Windows notification area (Fig. 16).

Volk Pictor Prestige Studio Event Monitor launches the software as the camera is connected to the PC. All images are imported from the camera automatically.



In case Volk Pictor Prestige Studio Pictor Prestige Studio Event Monitor is not running:

1. Start via standard Windows start menu (*Start>All Programs>Pictor Prestige Studio>Event Monitor*)
2. From installation directory (default:*C:\ Pictor Prestige Studio*) by running *run-monitor.bat* (with administrator rights).
3. Also, restart/start Event Monitor via Volk Pictor Prestige Studio application settings.

Image import can take several minutes. Once all images are imported, the software creates a study and opens it.

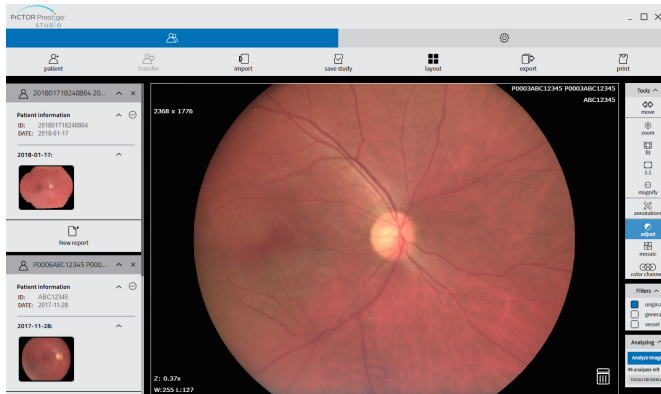


Figure 17. Volk Pictor Prestige Studio with imported images.

Images can also be imported manually. To upload images or videos, press “Import” button in the toolbar.

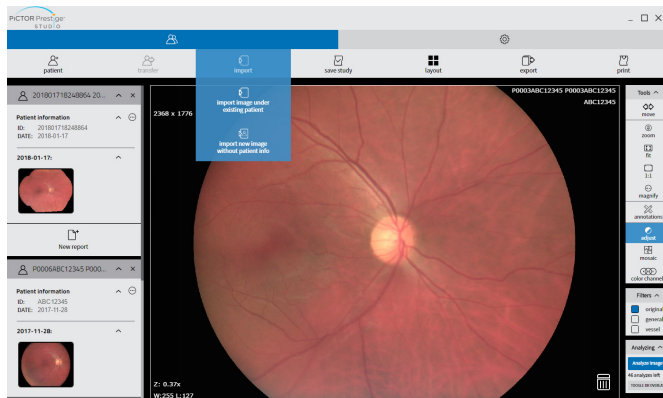


Figure 18. Importing image possibilities.

This will open the drop down with the following import possibilities:

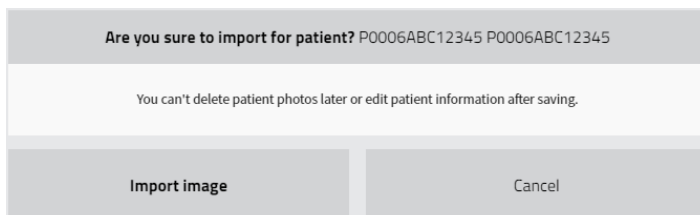



Figure 19. Image import confirmation.

To **import image under existing patient** that will be updated. Once this option is selected a confirmation message pops-out, notifying that after saving patient information and photos, the editing or deleting is not possible (Fig. 19). To proceed, press “Import image”. Another message will pop-out (Fig. 20), informing that image import for specific patient is done successfully.



To **import a new image without patient information**. Once this option is selected, file selection dialog will be opened to select multiple local files (*.jpg or *.mp4).

8. UPLOADING NEW PATIENT TO CAMERA

Once you connect camera, in the toolbar menu “Transfer” button is activated. To upload new patient to camera, select “Add new patient to camera” button (highlighted in the red rectangle). It is used to create the patient manually and send patient information to the camera.

 The button is shown only when the camera is connected and Remote Worklist server is configured.

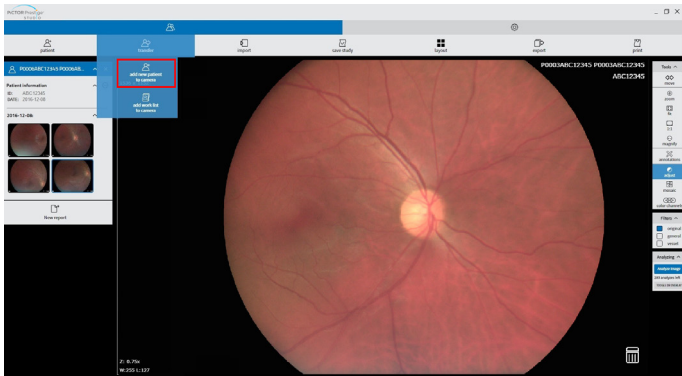


Figure 21. Add new patient to camera.

A pop-out window will appear. Write patient`s ID, Last Name, First Name, select the Sex and indicate the Date of Birth.



After entering the required information, a message informing that the patient was added to the camera appears.

Click “Cancel” button to revoke all changes.

9. UPLOADING WORKLIST TO CAMERA

Once you connect camera, the “Transfer” button in the toolbar menu is activated. To upload worklist to camera, select “Add work list to camera” button (highlighted in the red rectangle). This button is used to send the list of today’s patients from the worklist to the camera.

 The button is shown only when the camera is connected and Remote Worklist server is configured.

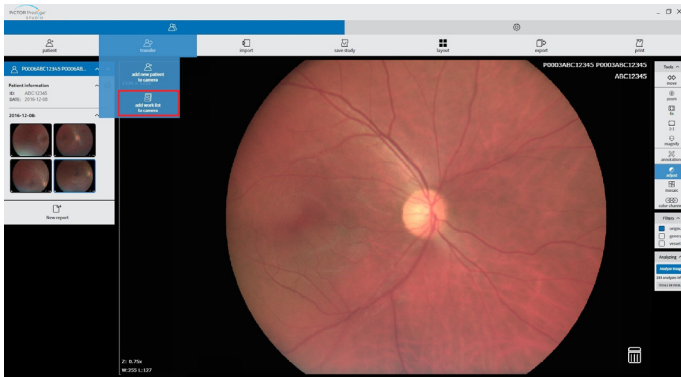


Figure 23. Add Worklist to camera

Once user clicks “Upload Worklist to camera” button, a notification of how many patients were sent to the camera from the Worklist appears.

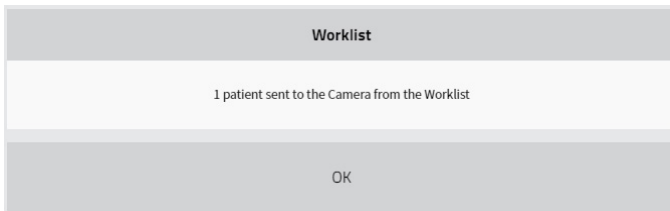


Figure 24. Notification of successful patient sent from the Worklist.

The patient list also appears in the camera:

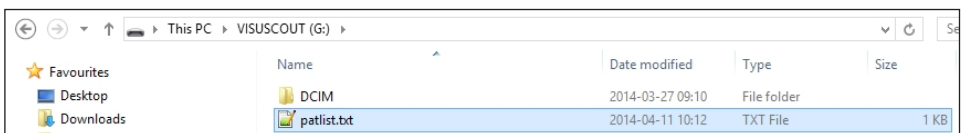


Figure 25. Patient list in the camera.

10. OPEN IMAGE

There are two ways to open image from the study: drag-and-drop and by clicking image thumbnail (depends on Settings).

First method:

1. Just drag selected image thumbnail into the pane.

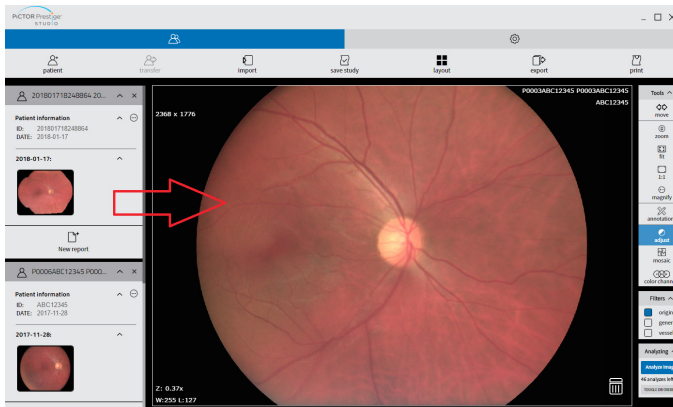


Figure 26. Drag-and-drop method.

Second method:

1. Select the pane where you want to move the image, with a single mouse click. The active pane will be outlined in blue.
2. Double click (or single click - see Settings>Screen layout>Thumbnail single-click) on the image thumbnail.
3. The image will appear in the selected pane.



The image is sent in five successive stages whose relative sizes are 1 : 1 : 2 : 4 : 8. That way a coarse version of the medical image can be shown after sending 1/16th of the data (this incremental display is called "Streaming").

11. UPDATE PATIENT INFO

After study import (or if opened), you will find “Update patient info” button in the study header.

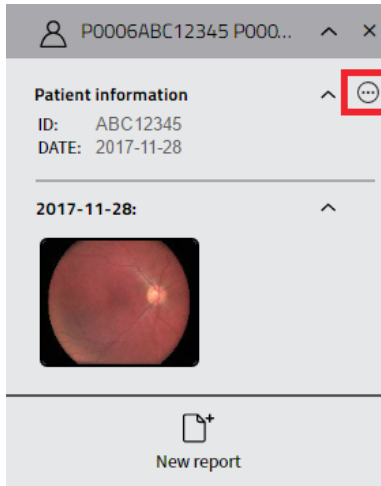


Figure 27. Open Update patient info window.

Once you press it, a following window will open. Here you can enter or edit patients' information.

Click “Cancel” to exit from the pop-up screen.

12. DELETE IMAGE

All images can be deleted. You need to open image into pane and click a recycle bin icon (highlighted in the red rectangle) which is at the bottom right corner of the pane.

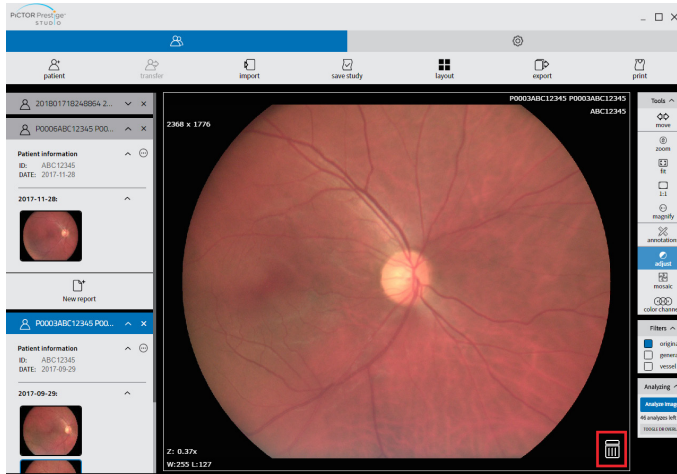


Figure 29. Delete button.

13. SAVE STUDIES

The last step is to save imported studies with all the changes (updated patient data, deleted images). After this, you cannot change the study.

To save the studies in the toolbar click “Save Study” button (highlighted in the red rectangle).

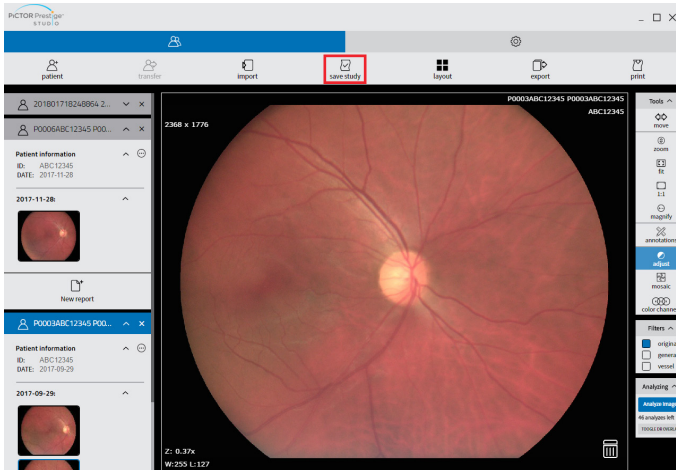


Figure 30. Save study button.

Before saving the study, review the information and update if necessary in the “Update and save the study” window.

Once “Save” is pressed, a confirmation window will pop-out, notifying that after saving patient information and photos, that editing or deleting is not possible.

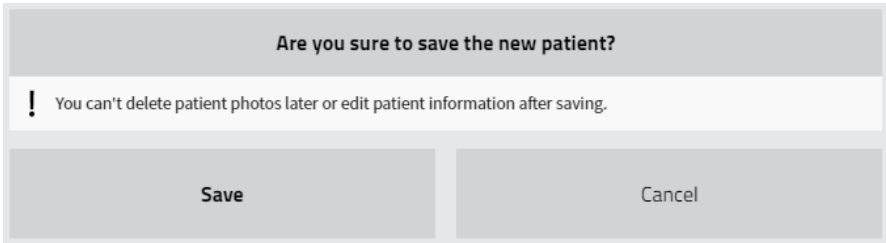


Figure 32. Confirmation window of saving new patient.

Saving can take several moments. The Progress bar will show the saving progress.

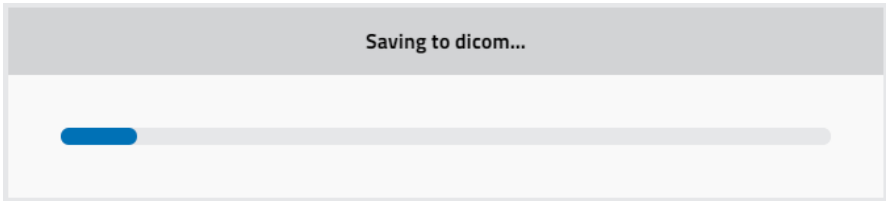


Figure 33. Save progress.



If more than one study is opened but not saved, all the opened studies will be saved by pressing “Save” button.

14. SEARCH OF PATIENTS

Volk Pictor Prestige Studio Pictor Prestige Studio user can perform a search between patients. To open a new patient, press “Patient” button (highlighted in the red rectangle).

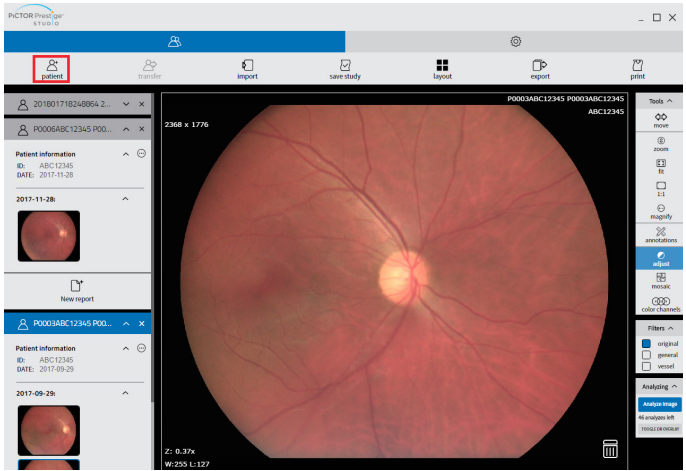


Figure 34. Search of patient window.

The following Open new patient screen appears:

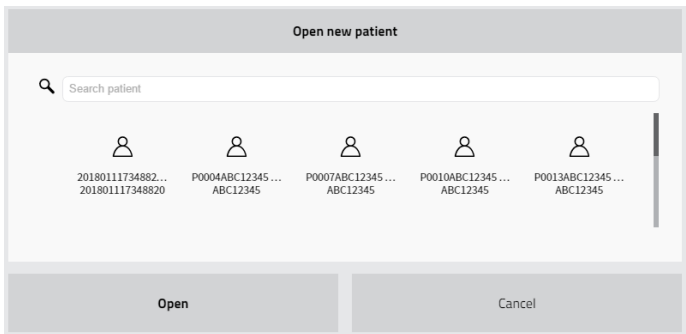


Figure 35. Open new patient window.

Search menu will help you to quickly find the studies you need. Write patient's ID, Last Name, First Name in the “Search patient” line and the patients with the entered information will be automatically filtered.

To select the patient, just click on it and press “Open”.

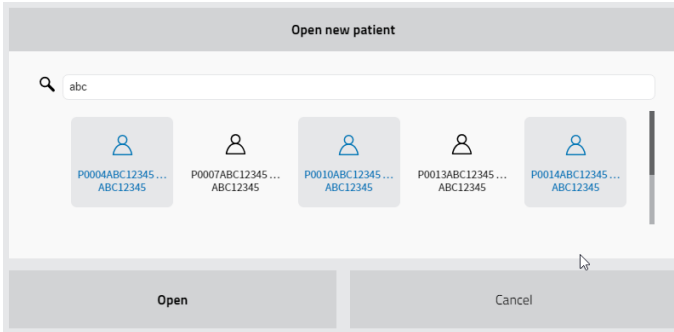


Figure 36. Custom selection of patients.



More than one patient can be selected in the “Open new patient” search window. The selected patients are highlighted in darker grey color (Fig. 36).

15. STUDY EXPORT

The study can be exported. To do so, press “Export” button (highlighted in the red rectangle).

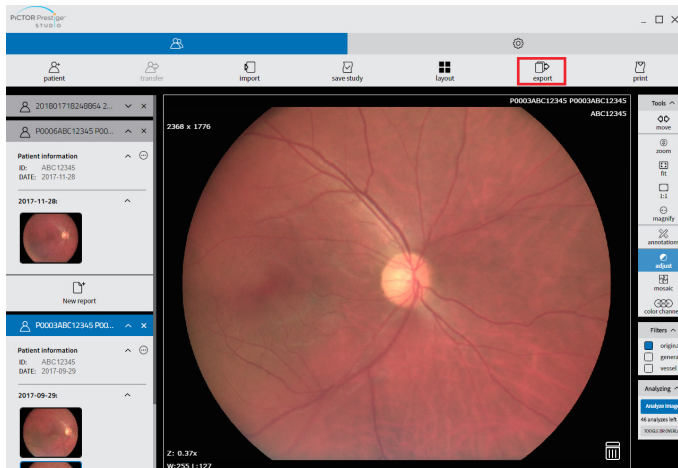


Figure 37. Export button.

The export window opens:

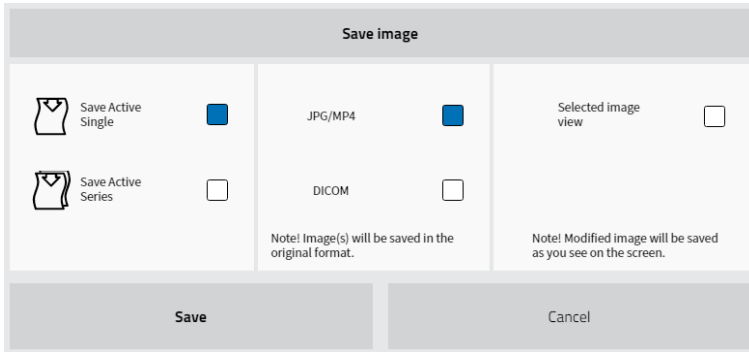


Figure 38. Export window.



Save Active Single: To export active image.

JPG/MP4: To export images/videos in JPG/MP4 format.



DICOM: To export images in DICOM format.



Selected image view: To export selected image as you see on the screen.

16. READ AND WRITE REPORTS

In the main Volk Pictor Prestige Studio window you can notice that some of the studies have annotations (reports). This is indicated by the “Report” icon which appears next to patient images (highlighted in the red rectangle):

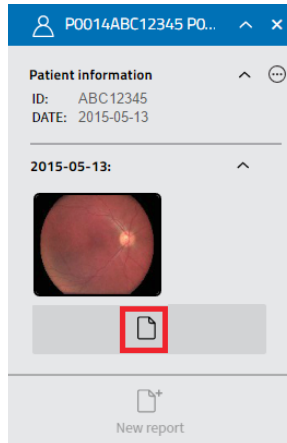


Figure 39. Report.

To read or edit the report:

1. From search window select study and open it.
2. Click the “Report” icon (Fig. 39) to open the annotation.
3. The report window will appear:

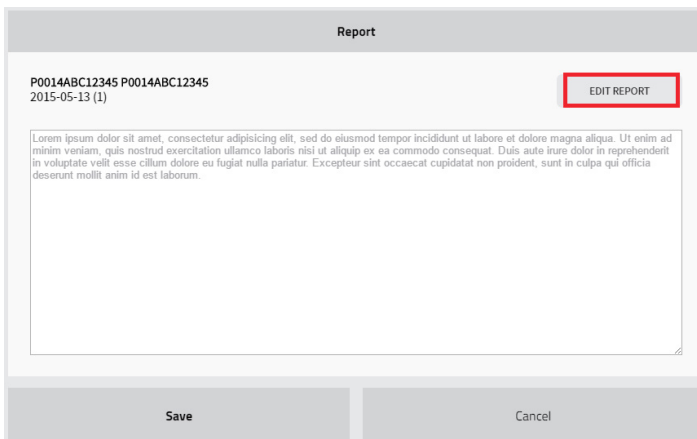


Figure 40. Report window.

4. To edit report, press “Edit report” button (highlighted in the red rectangle).

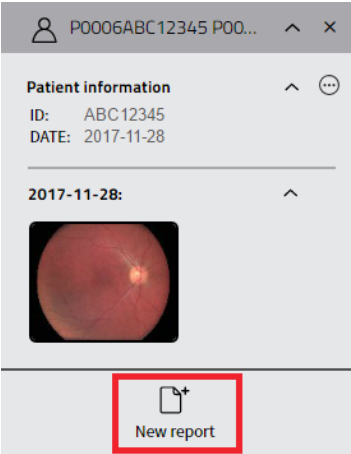


Figure 41. New report button.

To create a new report, click the “New report” button (Fig. 41), enter the required information and press “Save” button.

17. PRINTING IMAGES AND SERIES

To print images/series, press “Print” button (highlighted in the red rectangle):

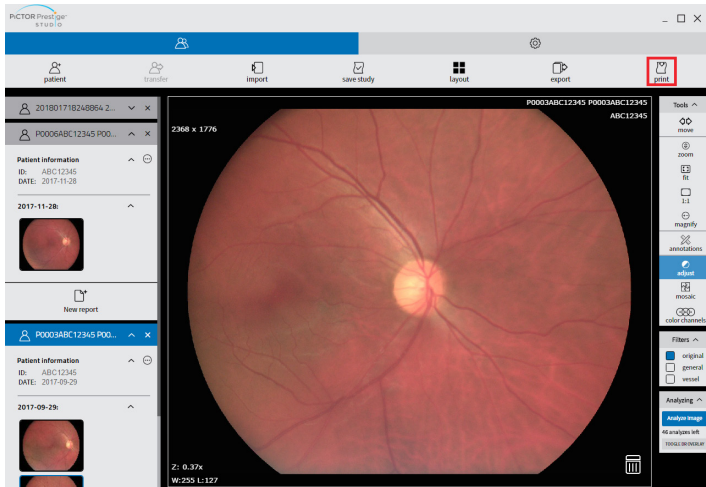


Figure 42. Print button.

Once pressed, a “Print image” selection window will open.

Print Single: To print a selected image.



Print Series: To print a whole series.



Print with report: To print a selected image with report.



Print all study images: To print a whole series with report.

After a few minutes the PDF report is generated. In order to print it, click print button in your PDF viewer (standard PDF printing).

Images will go after report text. If one image or row of images fits to the same page as report text, the images will be added to the same page after text and other images will go to the other pages.

18. VIEW, ANALYZE AND MEASURE IMAGES

18.1 VIEW ONE OR MULTIPLE IMAGES

Using Volk Pictor Prestige Studio tools in the toolbar, you may easily choose how many panes with study images will be shown in the window. There are these possibilities:



1:1

One pane



2:2

Four panes



1:2

Two panes vertically



2:3

Six panes



2:1

Two panes horizontally



3:3

Nine panes

To open more than four panes, do the following:

1. Click “Layout” button on the toolbar;
2. Choose from the list how many panes you want to see:

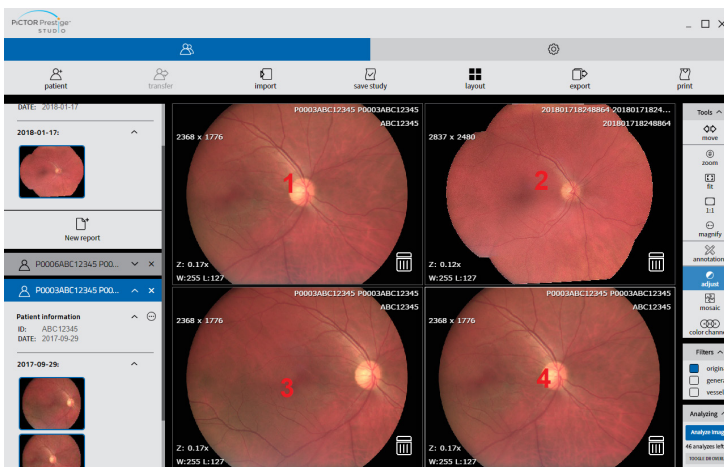


Figure 48. 2:2 screen layout.

18.2 ANALYZE IMAGES

You can analyze the study images according to the criteria you need. There are the following tools:



“**Move**” button helps to position images within the pane. This feature is especially useful when the image is larger than the pane, as it usually is after zooming.

To move an image within the pane:

- Click “Move” on the toolbar,
- Position the cursor over the image you want to move, click and drag the cursor around the pane to move the image.

Release the mouse button to drop the image in its new position.



“**Adjust**” the Level/Window of the image (brightness and contrast). Put your finger on the screen, pan up and down to control the brightness of the image. On non-touchscreen devices, drag the mouse upwards or downwards to control the brightness of the image.



Zoom in and zoom out the selected image. Click on the “Zoom” icon, press the left button on your mouse and drag it upwards to zoom in and downwards to zoom out.



When you click the “**Fit**” button, the size of the image is automatically adjusted so that the image fills the entire screen. For example, if only part of the image is visible on the screen, choose this button to see the whole image displayed on the entire screen.



When you click “**1:1**” button, the size of the image changes into its original size.



“**Mosaic**” button helps to form a single image from multiple images.



“**Color channels**” is used to highlight a color component or a combination of color components in the image by showing the selected color in white shades and other colors in black. Click on the button in order to choose from the list.



“**Magnify**” button is used to magnify (enlarge) the certain area of the image. Click the icon once in order to enable the function, click the icon again and the mode will be disabled.

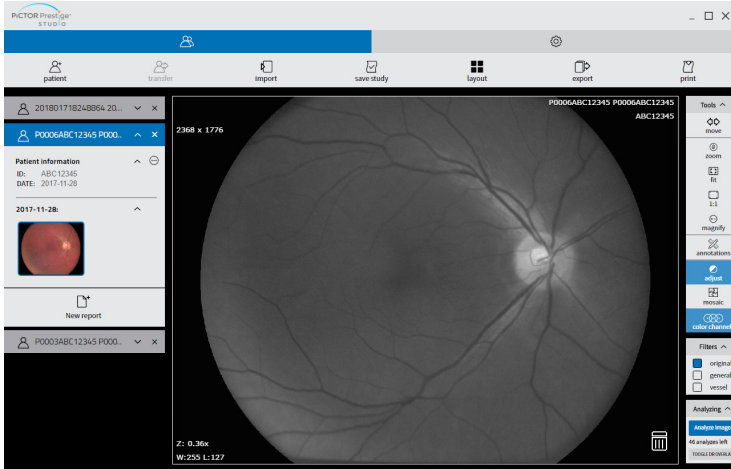


Figure 49. Color channels tool.

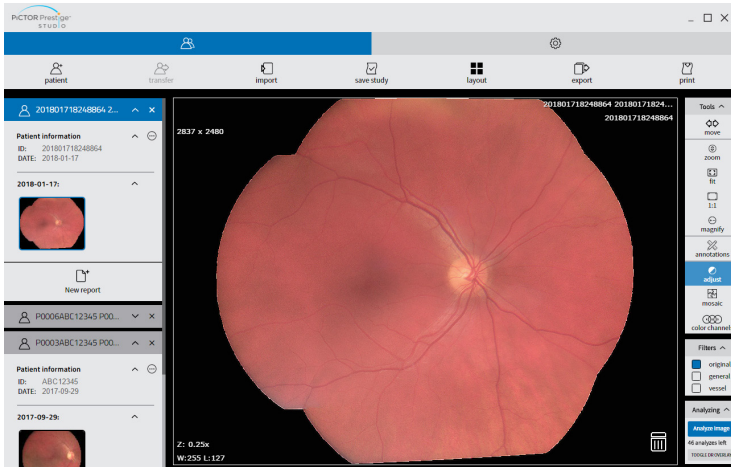


Figure 50. Image mosaic function.

18.3 ANNOTATION


Annotations can be marked, written, viewed and saved. Their presence is indicated by an active  mark next to the study image.

To **mark annotation**:

- The “Area” or “Arrow” buttons are used to mark or point with an arrow to the study image area which will be described in a text box (follow “To create annotation”);

Area button:

- Place the mouse cursor on the point from which you want to select the region of interest. Then click the left mouse button.
- Move the cursor to the second point and click the left mouse button again.
- Then move the cursor to the third, fourth, etc. points and each time click the left mouse button.
- When you reach the last point, click the left mouse button twice.

Arrow button:

- Place the mouse cursor on the starting point from which you want to start drawing an arrow.
- Click the left mouse button.
- Move the cursor to the end point and click the left mouse button once more.
- Once you have made any marks or manipulations of the study image, you can follow on writing an annotation.

To write annotation:

- The “Text” button is used to write annotation.
- Move your mouse cursor to the upper toolbar and select icon “Annotations”.
- Then select “Text” from the list.
- Annotation text window will appear:

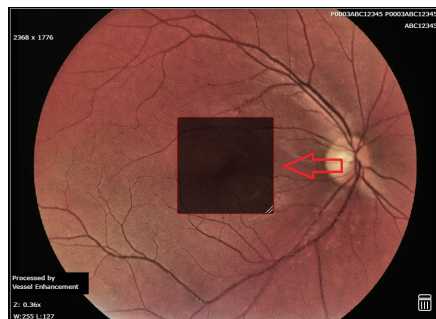


Figure 61. Text window.

- Click the left mouse button on the annotation text window and write an annotation.

To **save annotation:**

- Move your mouse cursor to the toolbar and select icon “Annotations”.
- Then select “Save Annotation” from the list.
- Annotation saving window will appear:



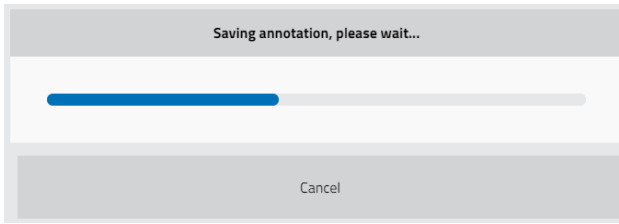


Figure 64. Saving annotation process window.

Once the saving process is finished, the following window will appear:

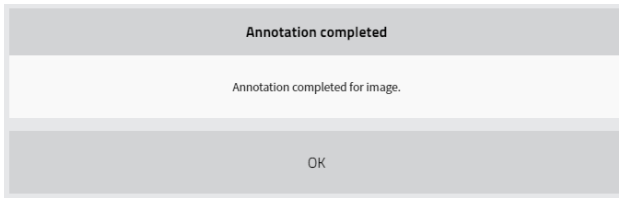


Figure 65. Saving annotation notification window.

- System saves annotation with the following information:
 - title.
 - description.
 - any drawn measurements/marks.
 - written text.
- Once the annotation has been saved, the annotation mark will appear active on the study image.

To view annotation:

- If there are several annotations, user can choose which one to review.
- In order to view the annotation, drag and drop the study image (the one that has the annotation) to the main screen:

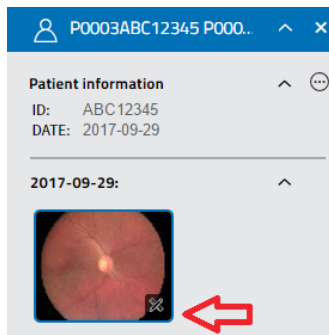


Figure 66. Annotations icon on Volk Pictor Prestige Studio.

- Move your mouse cursor to the “Annotations” icon.
- Click on the icon and choose an annotation from the list:

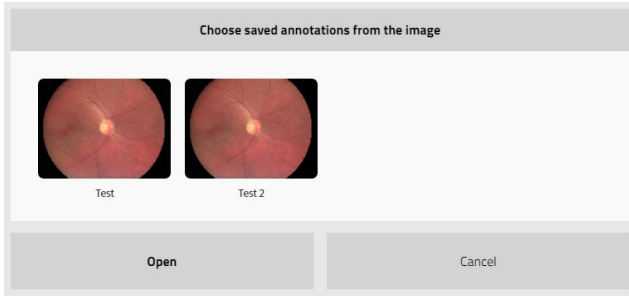


Figure 67. List of annotations.

- Click on the annotation you have chosen to view, then click “Open” and the saved annotation will appear on the screen with an information that has been saved previously:

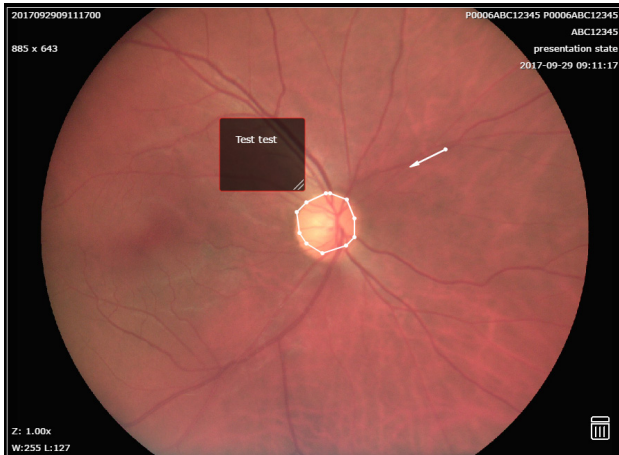


Figure 68. View annotation on Volk Pictor Prestige Studio.

To **print annotation:**

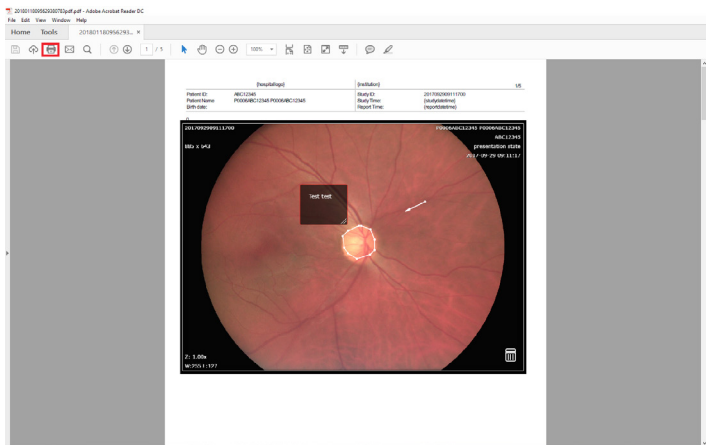



Figure 70. Printable PDF file.

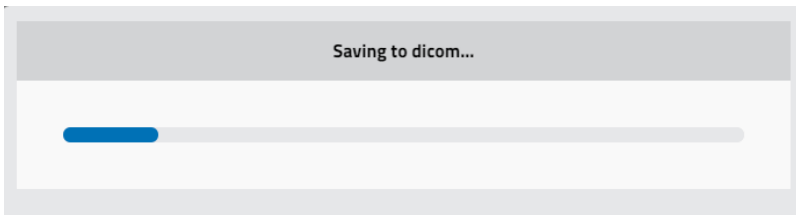


Figure 72. Saving process.

19. SETTINGS



To change settings of Volk Pictor Prestige Studio software, click “Settings” button in the toolbar and the settings window will open.

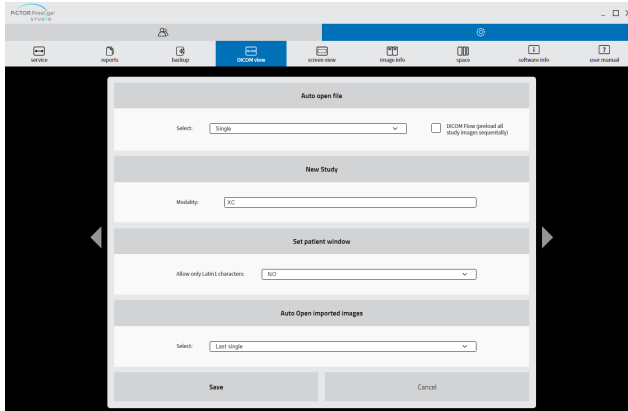


Figure 73. DICOM view settings tab.

In the “DICOM View” tab the following parameters are indicated:

Modality:	Set the modality for the new study.
Allow only Latin1 characters:	Once the option is activated, only Latin1 characters can be entered in the Set Patient window.

Auto open file:

No	Will not open an imported file automatically.
Single	If a single image was imported, will open this image in an empty pane.
Always	Will always open an imported file automatically.
DICOM Flow (preload all study images sequentially)	Preloads all study images sequentially.

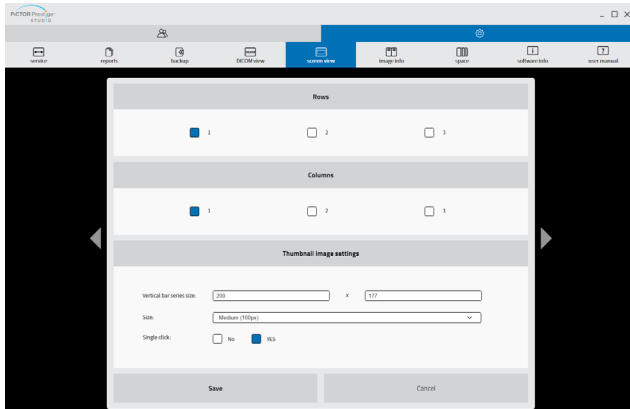


Figure 74. Screen view tab.

In the “Screen view” tab the following parameters are indicated:

Rows	Indicates the layout`s number of rows (maximum 3).
Columns	Indicates the layout`s number of columns (maximum 3).
Vertical Bar series size	Indicates the size of thumbnails series bar.

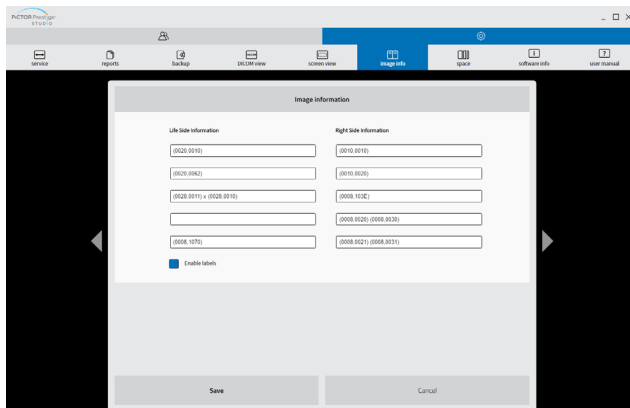


Figure 75. Image info tab.

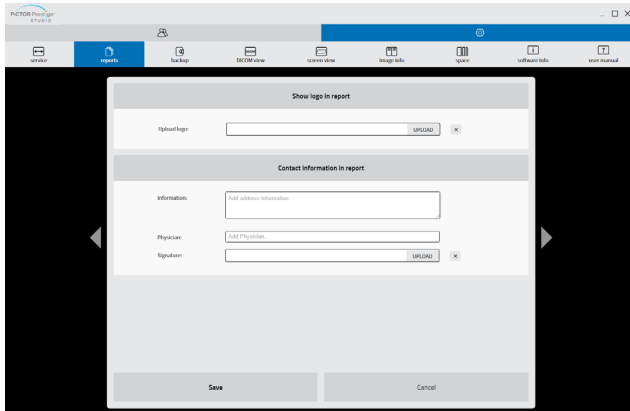


Figure 76. Reports tab.

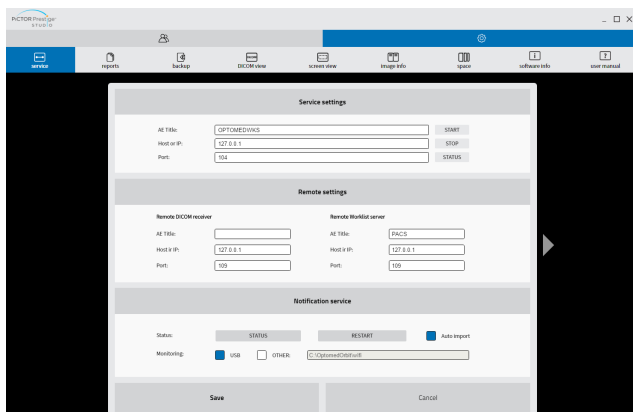


Figure 77. Service tab.

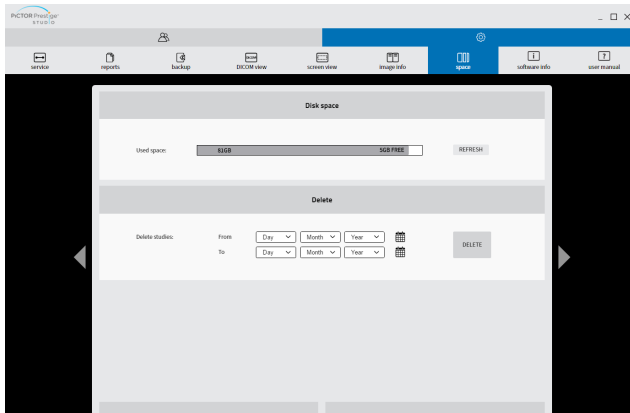


Figure 78. Space tab.

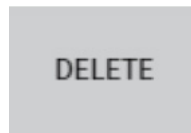

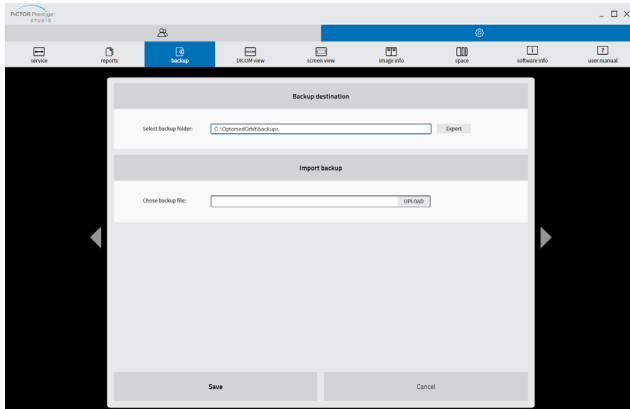


Figure 80. Backup tab.

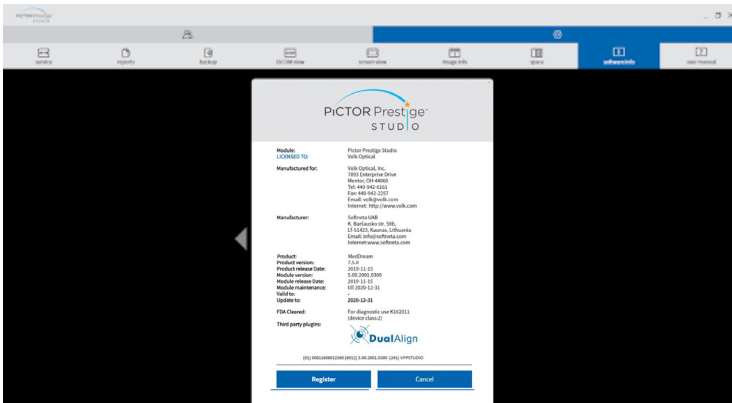


Figure 81. Software info tab.

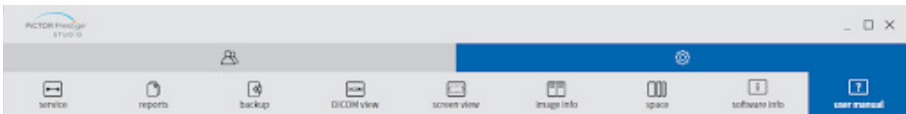


Figure 83. Information window.
